# CHECKLIST FOR DEVELOPING A WORKPLACE/JOB SITE SAFETY PLAN

This checklist contains a compilation of best practices and guidelines which have been published by CDC, OSHA and other sources to address safety hazards due to the coronavirus. It can be used as a guide in developing a written Safety Plan for operating during the new normal.

Each company's plan will be unique based on factors like facilities and job sites, manufacturing functions and number of employees. Make the plan flexible enough so that it can be adapted as evolving orders and guidelines are published by federal, state and local governments. For any items that receive a "no," consider establishing an alternative approach to ensuring safety in that area.

## COVID-19 Company Specific Planning

- YES NO Create a pandemic team from a cross-section of the organization
- YES NO Designate a pandemic team leader to coordinate and direct activity
- YES NO Develop a written plan within the corporate framework and government protocols

## Workplace/Job Site Hygiene

- YES NO Verify that hot water stations with liquid soap and/or hand sanitizer are easily accessible, along with COVID-19 handwashing instructions
- YES NO Make disinfectants available to workers throughout the worksite and ensure cleaning supplies are frequently replenished
- YES NO Develop guides for cleaning and frequency that specifically address high-touch surfaces and heavy usage areas
- YES NO Establish daily cleaning of restrooms or portable toilets and ensure facilities for washing hands after use
- YES NO Use EPA-approved cleaning chemicals from List N or that have label claims against the coronavirus
- YES NO Add clearly indicated and strategically placed waste receptacles

## Safety Steps Before Shifts Start

- YES NO Initiate daily self-reporting for all workers
- YES NO Make temperature checks available as part of self-reporting
- YES NO Document daily that these controls are in place
- YES NO Ensure that symptomatic workers stay at home or are sent home
- YES NO Wash/sanitize all incoming deliveries and materials
- YES NO Limit or restrict non-essential visitors
- YES NO Ensure proper PPE is available and being worn correctly
- YES NO Provide alcohol-based wipes for use when equipment must be shared, and instruct workers in proper cleaning techniques

## Social Distancing

- YES NO Initiate phases for returning the workforce over the course of weeks to allow for adequate training and social distancing
- YES NO Establish shift sizes appropriate to maintain 6' separation in work areas
- YES NO Put safety and distance signage and markings in place
- YES NO Ensure that social distancing is maintained during breaks

## Social Distancing

Create and communicate protocols to best manage social distancing:

- YES NO While waiting for and using elevators
- YES NO While waiting for and using time clocks
- YES NO In break rooms, dining areas, and other common areas
- YES NO Organize meetings, training, toolbox talks, etc., to meet distancing guidelines; utilize phone or video; limit the number of attendees for in-person meetings; hold meetings outdoors
- YES NO Use physical barriers if necessary to define and secure work zones

## Personal Protective Equipment

Prioritize and communicate policies for PPE use during work and breaks. This includes:

- YES NO Gloves
- YES NO Facial coverings or masks
- YES NO Eye Protection
- YES NO Face Shields
- YES NO Shower Stations, if required by work activities

## Communications and Training

- YES NO Display appropriate CDC COVID-19 safety signage prominently
- YES NO Implement COVID-19 training for all employees
- YES NO Provide all employees written communications about the COVID-19 plan
- YES NO Monitor continued adherence to the COVID-19 Safety Plan

## Exposure Response Plan

Identify appropriate steps should exposure be suspected, including:

- YES NO Procedure to quarantine in the event of personnel exposure
- YES NO How to transport patient to a health care provider
- YES NO Plan to remove all workers from area of exposure
- YES NO Protocol for cleaning all areas of exposure
- YES NO Method for tracing connections to other workers
- YES NO Requirements before returning to work
